

A REPORT – A.B.C 2011

An enlarged Executive meeting of ABC, held on Friday 25th November 2011 and the conference on the 26th November 2011.

The enlarged executive meeting was chaired by Mr. T.K Ekaney, Chairman of the Steering committee. The meeting started at about 8.30pm in the court Hall of Tombel with 31 persons in attendance.

The chairman welcomed members apologizing for the late start. He also took time to explain to members that the conference did not hold last year because the new BACDA-USA executive needed time to settle down.

This meeting had two objectives:

1. To review and adopt the constitution of ABC.
2. To put in place committees that will lead ABC for the next two years.

The name “All Bakossi Conference” was debated and maintained as an “ASSOCIATION” duly defined in the constitution and registered as such in BANGEM.

The second modification was that, we establish chapters wherever there is a strong presence of Bakossi people, not necessarily corresponding to Regions, Divisions or Sub Divisions.

The third modification of the constitution was the composition of the executive of the steering committee. We now have a president and Vice (new), A Secretary and Vice (new). The rest of the positions remain unchanged.

Concerning the second objective, committees were put in place, with new and old members inclusive. (See attached list of committees)

A financial Statement from 2008 – 2011 was readout (see attached)

On the second day, 26th November 2011, the conference took place with a lot of animation. The chairman of the conference was Chief Salle, Chief of Tombel. The Mayor Tombel and her assistants were conspicuously absent. The Minister, Prof. Ngolle Ngolle Elvis was represented by Mr. Mbong Walters Mesumbe –his Private Secretary.

The highlight of that occasion was a presentation of the socio – economic study of Kupe Muanenguaba Division, the presentation of the study for a tarred road and fundraising. During the fundraising, participants were very enthusiastic, and the contributions were received from a cross- section of the society and not limited to the wealthy.

The amount raised on the spot stood at 3,274,000 FCFA, Pledges: 300,000FCFA and Checques of 500,000FCFA from Dr. Eneme Andrew Ngome being pledge for ABC 2008 in Bangem.

The conference ended with entertainment of participants. The next ABC shall take place in Bangem at the end of 2013.
